Currently, at Rotterdam-Ruimzigt, the mangrove has degraded and there is imminent threat to a breach of the embankment. The foreshore has reached unprecedented elevation resulting in intense hydraulic loading and substantial loss of mangrove forests. At Cottage, there is a total loss of the mangrove forest and there is overtopping resulting in saline water intruding into connecting canals affecting farmlands. Additionally, the Cottage sluice is subjected to erosion and under threat of undermining which would eventually compromise the integrity of the structure.
