1. This Act may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Act, 1971, and amends the Trade Ordinance, 1958, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance.

- 2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of subsection (4) and the substitution therefor of the following subsection
 - "(4) Any person who commits a breach of any order made under this section shall, on summary conviction, be liable to—
 - (a) a fine of not less than five hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars and to imprisonment for not less than three months nor more than twelve months;
 - (b) a fine of not less nor more than one thousand dollars together with imprisonment for not less nor more than twelve months, on a second or subsequent occasion.".
