AN ACT to amend the Widows and Orphans Pension Ordinance.

A.D. 1972

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title:

Cap. 75

1. This Act may be cited as the Widows and Orphans Pension (Amendment) Act, 1972, and amends the Widows and Orphans Pension Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of socion 2 of Chapter 75.

- 2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following definition for the definition of the expression "the directors"
 - "the directors" means the Board of Directors constituted by section 12;

- 3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects
 - (a) by the substitution of the following subsection for subsection (2) —
 - "(2) The medical examination shall be made
 - (a) in Guyana, by a medical practitioner in the public service designated for the purpose by the Ministry responsible for health;
 - (b) in the case of an officer who is for the time being in a place outside Guyana for the purpose of performing the functions of his office, by two persons designated for the purpose by the directors from among persons in that place who, if they had been required to perform the said examination in Guyana, would be duly qualified medical practitioners for that purpose;" and
 - (b) by the substitution of the words "person or persons" for the word "Board" in subsection (3).
- Repeal of sections 7 and 8 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby and 8 of Chapter 75.

 4. Sections 7 and 8 of the Principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and the following section inserted as section 7—

'Medical examination and refund of contribution.

- 7. The directors shall, by notice in writing, request every officer appointed after 1st July, 1923, to submit himself for medical examination at such place and at such time to be specified in the notice, or at such other place and time as may be appointed by them, and if the officer fails to submit himself for the medical examination no refund of his contributions to the fund shall be made to him in the event of his ceasing to be an officer, or to his legal personal representative in case of his death, unless the directors for good and sufficient cause shown to their satisfaction approve of the refund being made.".
- Section 9 (1) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment amended by the substitution of the words "person or persons of section of Chapmaking the examination" for the word "Board" wherever it ap-ter 75. nears.
- Subsection (1) of section 12 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment is hereby repealed and the following subsection substituted there- of section 12 for ter 75.
 - "(1) The Fund shall be administered by a Board of Directors which shall be a body corporate consisting of five directors with the name of the Board of Directors of the New Widows and Orphans' Fund: the Accountant General shall be a director and the Chairman of the Board by virtue of his office and the other directors shall be appointed as hereinafter provided".
- The following section is hereby inserted in the Prin-Insertion of cipal Ordinance immediately after section 12 as section 12A in Chapter thereof -

75.

'Powers of the directors money on the security of a mortgage.

- 12A (1) The directors may, with the approval of the Minister, lend any part of the fund on the security of a mortgage on movable or immovable property in Guyana and may accept any such mortgage or any transfer or assignment thereof, and may sell, transfer, assign or cancel any such mortgage.
 - (2) The directors may, if they think fit, acquire any property if they think it necessary for the satisfaction of debts due to them by virtue of subsection (1).".

Amendment of section 15 of Chapter

8 Subsection (3) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of a full stop for the colon after the word "fund" and by the deletion of the proviso thereto.

General amendment of Chapter 75.

- 9. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects
 - (a) by the substitution of the word "Accountant General" for the word "Treasurer" wherever it occurs;
 - (b) by the substitution of the words "Deputy Accountant General" for the words "Deputy Treasurer" wherever they occur;
 - (c) by the substitution of the word "Minister" for the words "Governor" and "Governor-in-Council" wherever they occur.

Validation and saving provisions.

- 10. (1) Anything done by the directors of the New Widows and Orphans' Fund prior to the commencement of section 7 in purported exercise of the powers conferred by section 12A of the Principal Ordinance as enacted by section 7 shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done as if it were done by the Board of Directors of the Fund.
- (2) Any refund of contributions made before the commencement of this Act to a person who had ceased to be an officer, or to his legal personal representative in case of his death, contrary to the provisions of section 7 or 8 of the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to have been lawfully made, and the directors may, after such commencement, in their discretion, make a refund of contributions to a person who, prior to such commencement had ceased to be an officer, or to his legal personal representative in case of his death, where the officer had failed to submit himself for a medical examination within the prescribed period for the period of becoming a contributor.
