ORDINANCE No. 33 of 1950.

An Ordinance further to amend the Cinematograph (British Films) Ordinance, 1933.

[7th October, 1950.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, A.D. 1950. with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cinematograph Short title. (British Films) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed and read as one with the Cinematograph (British Films) No. 42 of Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal 1933. Ordinance.
