## ORDINANCE No. 48 of 1950.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, Chapter 185, with respect to the grant of licences to instal, use or work amateur wireless stations.

- BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana, with the A.D. 1950 advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: —
- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be construed with the Post and Telegraph Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Cap. 185 Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
