BRITISH GUIANA

ORDINANCE No. 10 OF 1955.

An Ordinance further to amend the Teachers Pensions Ordinance with respect to the rate of pension.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1955

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Teachers Pensions Short title (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955 and shall be construed and read as one with the Teachers Pensions Ordinance, hereinafter re- Cap. 197 ferred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section three A of the Amend Principal Ordinance as inserted by section three of the Teachers ment of Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1938, is hereby amended by section 3A the substitution for the words "a gratuity equal to ten times the Principal amount" of the words "a gratuity equal to twelve and one half Ordinance. times the amount".

Amendment of section 3B (4) of the Principal Ordinance. No. 42 of 1951.

3. Subsection (4) of section three B of the Principal Ordinance as inserted by section two of the Teachers Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "a gratuity equal to ten times the amount" of the words "a gratuity equal to twelve and one half times the amount".
