BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 42 OF 1955.

An Ordinance to amend the Labour Ordinance, 1942.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Labour (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Labour Ordinance, 1942, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (2) of section twelve of the Principal Ordin- Amendment ance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "six of subsection (2 months" in the sixth line thereof of the words "two years", and of section for the words "those months" in the thirteenth line thereof of the 12 of the words "the said period".

- 3. Nothing in this Ordinance shall—
- (a) affect any proceedings instituted before the commencement of this Ordinance; or
- (b) empower a Court to order an employer to pay any sum in respect of wages which have become due more than one year prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.
