## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 43 OF 1955.

An Ordinance further to amend the Limitation Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana: -

A.D. 1955.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Limitation (Amend- short title. ment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be construed and read as one with the Limitation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Cap. 184. Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
- 2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amend- Amendment ed by the substitution for the words "one year" in the second line of the Printhereof, of the words "six years".

Provisions as to actions already barred and pending ac-

- 3. Nothing in this Ordinance shall—
- (a) enable any action to be brought which was barred before the commencement of this Ordinance, except in so far as the cause of action or right of action may have been revived by an acknowledgement or part-payment made in accordance with the provisions of the Principal Ordinance; or
- (b) affect any action instituted before the commencement of this Ordinance.
