## BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE No. 1, of 1956.

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1954.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Short title. (Postponement of Elections) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Municipal Councils (Postponement of Elections) Ordinance, 1954, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. (1) Subsection (1) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- by the insertion after the words "The Governor may" at the beginning thereof of the words "from time to time";
- by the insertion after the words "either of them" (b) of the words "or any provision thereof": and

- (c) by the insertion after the words "such parts of this Ordinance" of the words "or such provisions thereof".
- (2) Subsection (2) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

by the insertion after the word "Ordinance" of the (a) words "or any provision thereof";

by the insertion after the words "such Part" of the (b) words "or such provision";

by the substitution for the words "the said Part" of (c) the words "this Ordinance"; and

by the substitution for the words "six months" of (d) the words "three months".

(3) Subsection (3) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words "the Proclamation issued under the said subsection in relation to the said Part" the words "any Proclamation issued under this section".

Passed by the Legislative Council this fifth day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
