### Arrangement of Sections.

AN ORDINANCE to repeal the Government Currency Notes Ordinance, and to make provision for the winding up of the Note Security Fund established thereunder.

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient to repeal the said Government Currency Notes Ordinance and to make provision for the winding up of the Note Security Fund established thereunder:

BE IT THEREFORE enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Currency Notes (Repeal) Ordinance, 1956.

2. The Government Currency Notes Ordinance is hereby repealed.

3. All moneys standing or accruing to the credit of the Note Security Fund established under the Government Currency Notes Ordinance are hereby transferred to the credit of the general revenue of the Colony, and any disbursement which but for the repeal of the said Ordinance would have been properly made from the said Fund shall be paid from moneys to be appropriated out of the general revenue of the Colony.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of August, 1951.
