ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

Section.

- 1. Short Title.
- 2. Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance.

An Ordinance to amend the Auctioneers Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana: -

A.D. 1956.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Auctioneers (Amend-Short title. ment) Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Auctioneers Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Chapter 349. Principal Ordinance.

Chapter 150.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereafter of the following proviso —

"Provided that any person may, if authorised by the Local Government Board, sell at auction without a licence any lands under the provisions of Section 152 of the Local Government Ordinance."

Passed by the Legislative Council this thirtieth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
