1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Labour (Conditions of Employment of Certain Workers) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Labour

(Conditions of Employment of Certain Workers) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Amendment of section 3 of Chapter 110.

- 2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by -
 - (a) the deletion of the words "second column of the" appearing therein; and
 - (b) the deletion of the proviso thereto, and the substitution therefor of the following:—

"Provided that the Governor in Council may from time to time by Order published in the Gazette vary, alter, or amend any of the particulars contained in the schedule aforesaid as he thinks fit."

Repeal and re_enactment of schedule to Chapter 110.

3. The schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—

(ii) Where any of the above workers is required to wear a uniform, such uniform shall be supplied and kept laundered free of charge by the employer.

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed during any period of time mentioned in this schedule in more than one category set out above, in respect of which different minimum rates of wages are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed in any of the above categories for any shorter period of time than the appropriate period set out above shall be the appropriate minimum rate of wages set out above in respect of the last mentioned period."
