Arrangement of Sections

## Section

- 1. Short title.
- 2. Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government. Schedule.

An Ordinance to appropriate the supplies granted in the current Session of the Legislative Council.

WHEREAS of the amount of fifty-four million, nine hundred and forty-eight thousand, seven hundred and ninety-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, nineteen

hundred and sixty-one, the sum of five million, six hundred and eighty-one thousand, one hundred and eighty-six dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of forty-nine million, two hundred and sixty-seven thousand, six hundred and eleven dollars:

A.D. 1961. Short title. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1961.

Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government. 2. The Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate forty-nine million, two hundred and sixty-seven thousand, six hundred and eleven dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year.
