2. Section 132 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by relettering paragraph (1) of subsection (1) thereof as paragraph (m); and
- (b) by the insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (1)—

“(1) the award of scholarships, exhibitions, bursaries, or other educational awards to any person whom the Council might think fit and on such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Council.”
