- This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Short title. Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter Cap. 152. referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.
- The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion Insertion of therein immediately after section 189 of the following section — "Receiving 189A. (1) The pound keeper, or someone appointed by 152.

and delivering strays.

- the Council as his deputy shall constantly be at hand at all times to receive all strays, and in default thereof, the pound keeper or his deputy, as the case may be, shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding ten dollars for each time he or his deputy is so absent.
- (2) The pound keeper, or someone appointed by the Council as his deputy, shall constantly be at hand between the hours of six o'clock in the morning and six o'clock in the evening to deliver all strays, and in default thereof shall be subject to the penalty prescribed for a default in the preceding subsection."
- Section 193 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment by the insertion immediately after the word "sections" of the figures of Section 193 and comma "15,".
