BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 👍 OF 1933.

An Ordinance to amend the Savings Bank Ordinance, Chapter 48, with respect to the amount that may be deposited in a financial year.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Savings Bank Ordinance, Short Title. 1933, and shall be construed with the Savings Bank Ordinance, Cap. 48. hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Repeal of sec. 7 of Cap. 48.

- 2. Section seven of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following is substituted therefor:—
- Maximum amount of deposit in a financial year.
- "7.—(1) The Colonial Treasurer shall not receive from any one depositor during any financial year any sum or sums of money which, together with any interest which may accrue to him in respect of the previous financial year, shall entitle him to be credited at any time during the year with more than one thousand dollars.
- (2) There shall be no limit to the amount which may be deposited on behalf of any Government department or any fund controlled by any Government department."

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.
