

## - BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 9 OF 1933.

An Ordinance to provide for the payment to general revenue of A.D. 1933 fines and penalties and the proceeds of forfeitures and seizures.

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Penalties (Revenue Appro- Short Title. priation) Ordinance, 1933.
- 2. Subject to any power or authority vested in the Governor to Fines, remit any fines, penalties or forfeitures or to restore any seizures, penalties and the protect amount of every fine and penalty which shall be recovered in a ceeds of for-

court of summary jurisdiction and the proceeds of every forfeiture and seizure made or incurred subject to the process of the court shall be paid to the Colonial Treasurer for general revenue.

3. The Governor may authorise the payment from such moneys as the Legislative Council shall provide for the purpose of such rewards to such persons as he may think fit in order to secure the efficient protection of the revenue and for the prevention, discovery, suppression and prosecution of offences against the customs and inland revenue laws, and the laws and regulations relating to mining and crown lands.

Repeal.

4. The enactments mentioned in the first column of the schedule are repealed to the extent stated in the third column.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect as on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three.
