A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to amend the Pledge of Goods Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pledge of Goods (Amend-Short title. ment) Ordinance, 1965, and shall be construed and read with the Pledge of Goods Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Cap. 334. Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.
- Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by Amendment of section 2 the substitution for the definition of the expression "banker" of the of the Principal Ordinfollowing definition -
 - " "banker" means "banker" as defined by the Bank Notes Ordinance and includes any person approved by the Cap. 285. Minister for the time being charged with the responsibility for Agriculture as a lender for the purpose of making advances in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Loans Ordinance, 1965;".

3. Paragraph (b) of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is Amendment of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is Amendment of section 10 of the Principal Ordinance.

- to a planter, farmer, or other cultivator, upon the security of any sugar cane or other crop, or upon any padi or grain grown upon any estate, farm or other place of cultivation or the products thereof;".
- 4. Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance shall have effect as Amendment of section 11 if for the words "sugar or grain" wherever those words occur there of the Principal Ordinance substituted the words "grain, sugar, sugar cane or other crop".

5. Section 13 of the Principal Ordinance shall have effect as of section 13 if for the word "section" in line three thereof there were substituted the words and figure "sections 10 and".
