AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title. Cap. 298. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same

Amendment of section 9 of Chapter 298. No. 27 of 1955.

- 2. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance as amended by section 2 of the Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby further amended
 - (a) by the substitution for the figures "3.00" and "1.50" in item (28) of the figures "5.00" and "2.50" respectively;
 - (b) by the substitution for the figures "3.00" in item (30) of the figures "5.00"; and
 - (c) by the substitution for the figures "0.50" in item (30A) of the figures "0.75".

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

The stamp duties payable upon the issue of passports, collective travel certificates and travel permits and upon the renewal of passports are considered inadequate to cover the present day costs of their preparation and issue. This Bill therefore seeks to increase the stamp duties to be charged in respect of those documents.
