#### AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THE SUPPLIES GRANTED IN THE CURRENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS of the amount of fifty-four million, thirty-six thousand, eight hundred and eighty-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, the sum of five million, six hundred and eighty-one thousand, one hundred and eighty-six dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of forty-eight million, three hundred and fifty-five thousand, seven hundred and one dollars:

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation (1961) Short title. Ordinance, 1960.
- 2. The Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Gov-Accountant ernor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the General to defray exfirst day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and other repenses of Civil Government. sources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate fortyeight million, three hundred and fifty-five thousand, seven hundred and one dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several Schedule. charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year.
