AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE WITH RESPECT TO SPIRIT SHOP LICENCES.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana: -

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tax (Amendment) short title. Ordinance, 1956, and shall be construed and read as one with the Tax Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Cap. 298. Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section 42 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment by the substitution of a comma for the full-stop at the end of the section, and by the addition of the following thereafter — Principal ordinance. and if it is situate elsewhere in the Colony the sum of ordinance.

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

This Bill seeks to correct an omission which occurs in the Revised Edition of the Laws of the Colony.
