THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1957, (No. 3 of 1957).

UNDER SECTION 112 OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ORDINANCE, 1957, AND BY VIRTUE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOL-LOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

These Regulations may be cited as the Representation of the Short title. People (Remuneration of Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Representation of the People 1957. (Remuneration of Officers) Regulations, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

- (b) by the insertion after the figures "1957" in the definition of the expression "the Ordinance" of the words "as amended from time to time".

"Remuneration of returning officer and assistant electoral officer.

4A. Subject as hereinafter provided, the remuneration tions. payable to a returning officer and an assistant electoral officer in respect of any election shall be such sum being not less than \$250.00 or more than \$350.00 as the Chief Electoral Officer shall determine."

Insertion of new regula-tion 8A in Principal Regulations.

The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 8 of the following new regulation —

"Reserve pol! clerk.

8A. (1) Where more than one poll clerk has been appointed for a polling-place in any electoral district, the returning officer thereof may assign any such poll clerk to be a reserve poll clerk and direct him to hold himself in readiness to serve at the poll as a poll clerk if called upon to do so by the returning officer or his election clerk.

(2) Where a reserve poll clerk is called upon to serve at the poll in any polling place under the preceding paragraph, he shall, in respect of any such services, be paid the remuneration prescribed for a poll clerk's services with

reference to that polling-place.

(3) Where a reserve poll clerk is not called upon as aforesaid, he shall, if the Chief Electoral Officer thinks fit having regard to any services actually performed by him, be paid the remuneration prescribed for a poll clerk's services with reference to a polling-place at which there are not more than two compartments."

Amendment of regulation of Principal Regulations.

Regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended (a) by the insertion after the word "shall" in paragraph (3) of the words, "except where the Chief Electoral Officer

otherwise directs,"; (b) by the deletion of the words "other than polling-place officers in paragraph (4) and the insertion after

paragraph of the following proviso —

"Provided that this paragraph shall not apply to a polling-place officer unless its application to him is approved by the Chief Electoral Officer."; and

(c) by the deletion of paragraph (5) and the renumbering of

paragraph (6) as paragraph (5).
