ORDER**Made Under****UNIVERSITY OF GUYANA ACT****(Cap. 39:02)****IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 12(7) OF
THE UNIVERSITY OF GUYANA ACT, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -****Citation.**

1. This Order, which amends section 12(2) of the University of Guyana Act, may be cited as the University of Guyana (Amendment) Order 2024.

**Amendment of
section 12(2) of
the Principal
Act.**

2. Section 12(2) of the Principal Act is amended as follows –

- (a) by substituting for the words “twenty-six members”, the words “thirty-two members”;
- (b) in paragraph (j) –
 - (i) by substituting for the word “four”, the word “five”; and
 - (ii) by substituting for the words “Amerindians and business”, the words “Amerindians, business and youth”;
- (c) in paragraph (k), by inserting immediately after the word “Congress”, the words “and one person to be nominated by the Federation of Independent Trade Unions of Guyana”;
- (d) by substituting for paragraph (l), the following paragraph –

“(l) six persons to be appointed by the Minister who, in the Minister’s opinion, can contribute significantly to the University in the field of medicine, law, information and communications technology, environment and climate change, natural resources and national defence and security;”

(e) in paragraph (m) –


(i) by substituting for the word “six”, the word “four”;
and

(ii) by substituting for the full stop, a semi- colon; and

(f) by inserting immediately after paragraph (m), as so
amended, the following paragraph –

“(n) three persons to be appointed by the Minister from
persons nominated by Christian, Muslim and Hindu
organisations.”
