IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Employees in Dry Goods Stores) Order 1984*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Employees in Dry Goods Stores) (Amendment) Order 2002, and shall come into operation on 1st October, 2002.

Amendment of the Principal Order. 2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for the Schedule thereto of the Schedule hereto-
