APPROVAL OF ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE FOR 1976

In accordance with article 80(2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified that Cabinet had recommended that the Assembly should proceed upon the motion for the approval of the estimates of expenditure for the financial year 1976, totalling \$552,203,022, net of appropriation-in-aid, and excluding الله,741,771, which is changeable by law. (See Appendix).

The Minister of Finance then moved the motion and read the Budget Speech.

The motion was then proposed.

Thereafter, the Minister named Monday, 1st December, 1975, as the day for the resumption of the debate on the motion.

PARLIAMENT OFFICE, Public Buildings, Georgetown, 27th November, 1975. WHEREAS the Constitution of Guyana requires that estimates of the revenues and expenditure of Guyana for any financial year should be laid before the National Assembly not later than sixty days after the commencement of that year;

AND WHEREAS the Constitution also provides that when the estimates of expenditure have been approved by the Assembly an Appropriation Bill shall be introduced in the Assembly providing for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet that expenditure;

for the financial year 1976 have been prepared and laid before the Assembly on 24th November, 1975:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly approve the estimates of expenditure for the financial year 1976, of a total sum of five hundred and fifty-two million, two hundred and thr thousand, and twenty-two dollars, net of appropriation-in-aid, and excluding one hundred and eleven million, seven hundred and forty-one thousand, seven hundred and seventy-one dollars, which is chargeable by law, as detailed therein and summarized in the undermentioned schedule, and agree that it is expedient to amend the law and to make further provision in respect of finance.
