Clause 4: The Minister of Foreign Aff irs and Justice moved the following amendments:

- (a) Deletion of the word "and" at the end of paragraph (c);
- (b) Substitution of "(d)" for "(a) in the proposed section 19(2)(b) of paragraph (d);
- (c) Substitution of a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of clause 4 and addition of the word "and" immediately thereafter;
- (d) Insertion of the following paragraph as paragraph (e):
 - "(e) by the insertion of the following section as section 24A -

"Payment in bonds at discretion of the Minister and issue thereof. Cap.62:07

24A. Where any land is acquired under this Act the compensation for the land may, in the discretion of the Minister, be paid either in whole or in part by the issue of land bonds under the Land Bonds Act of such type as the Minister determines to a nominal amount equal to the amount of compensation payable or to such part thereof as may be determined by the Minister, as the case may be, and the provisions of the Land Bonds Act shall apply mutatis mutandis for the purpose subject, however, to the following modifications -

- (a) section 5(1) shall not apply;
- (b) for the words "two million dollars" in section 6(2), there shall be substituted the words "one hundred million dollars or such greater value as may be approved by resolution of the National Assembly'
- (c) for the reference in section 6(3) to section 4 of the Land Bonds Act there shall be substituted a reference to this section;
- (d) for the words "the passing of this Act" in section 6(3) there shall be substituted the words "the **exercise** of his powers under section 211 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act";
- (e) the following section shall be substituted for section 8 -
 - "Interest 8.(1) Land bonds shall on land bear interest at bonds. Such rate as the Minister shall determine.
 - (2) The interest upon the principal represented by each land bond shall run from the date specified in that behalf in the bond. Payment of interest in the case of each fixeddate or drawing bond and of principal and interest in the case of each annuity bond shall be made half-yearly on the data specified in that behalf in the bond, at the office of the Accountant General.
