INCHEADE IN LIABILITY OF GOVERNMENT IN RESPECT OF GUARANTEES

The Minister of Finance moved the following motion:

WHIREMS in accordance with section 3(1) of the Guarantee of Loans (Public Corporations and Companies) Lat, Cap 77:01, the Government may in such manner and on such terms and subject to such conditions as may be agreed between it and a lending agency -

- (a) guarantee the discharge by a Corporation of its obligations under any agreement which may be entered into by the Corporation with a lending agency in respect of any borrowing by that Corporation that is authorised by the Government:
- (b) assume such other obligations as may be agreed between the Government and a lending agency in relation to or pursuant to my such agreement;
- (•) undertake the repayment to a landing agency of much says as the landing agency may have advanced to or for the benefit of the Government:

AD CERES it is provided under section 4(1) of the aforesaid Act, that the aggregate amount of the liability of the Government in respect of guarantees given under section 3 of the Act shall not at any time exceed the sun of fifty million dollars or such greater sum as may from time to time be specified by the Lesolution of the National Assembly;

ID MINED it has become necessary to specify in accordance with the said section 4(1) a greater sum for the purpose of enabling the aggregate an unt of liability of the Government in respect of guarantees to be increased due to the extended activities of the Government and those incorporated bodies to which the Act applies, thich activities entail the acquisition of funds for capital outlay:

BE IT DESCRIVED:

That this National Assembly approve that the aggregate arount of the liability of the Government under section 4 (1) of the Guarantee of Loas (Public Corporations and Companies) Act, in respect of guarantees given under section 3 of the Act, shall not at any time exceed the sum of two hundred million dollars.

The Leader of the Opposition spoke to the motion.
Thereafter, the Minister of Fin nce replied.
The motion was then put and carried.

At 2.30 p.m., on a notion by the Minister of Parliamentary Affairs and Leader of the House, the Assembly was adjourned to addate to be fixed.
