The Leader of the Opposition moved and Cde. Roepu Daman Persaud seconded the following motion which was put and carried:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That this National Assembly recommends that steps be taken to amend the respective laws of Guyana to provide for declaring vacant the seats of Members of Municipalities and other Local Authorities who cease to support the Party on whose list they were elected to the Municipalities and Local Authorities.
