BILL Second and Third Readings

CO-OPERATIVE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS BILL 1976 - Bill No. 9/1976 published 10.6.76

In accordance with article 80 (2) of the Constitution, the Minister of Finance signified Cabinet's recommendation and moved the second realing of the following Bill:

A BILL intituled AN ACT TO MAKE ROVISION FOR THE ESTABLISH NEAT AND FUNCTIONS OF THE CO-OPERATIVE FINANCE ADMINISTRATION AND CO-OPERATIVE FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS UNDER ITS DURISDICTION.

The Deputy Speaker and Cde. Collymore spoke to the motion.

Thereafter, the Minister of Finance replied.

Clause 39: A motion by Cde. Reepu Daman Persaud for the deletion of the clause and negatived.

Clause 39 was then passed as printed.

Clause 40: A motion by Cde. Reepu Daman Persaud for the delotion of subsection: (3) was put and negatived.

Clause 40 was then passed as printed.

Clauses 41 to 50 were passed as printed.

- <u>Clause 61:</u> The following amendments by the Minister of Finance were <u>put end carried:</u>
 - (i) <u>Insertion</u> of the following after paragraph (c) of subsection (1):
 - " (d) the GNCB Trust Company Limited, ";
 - (ii) Substitution of the following for subsection (2):
 - "(2) An order under secti n 15 reconstituting the Guyana National Co-operative Bank and the GNCB. Trust Company Limited by establishing them as financial institutions under this Act may, in addition to the provisions which may be included therein pursuant to sectiom 15(12), contain provisions relating to the allotment of shares in the financial institutions so established to the shareholders of the said Bank and the said Company, respectively. "; and

- (iii) Insertion of the following after paragraph (b)
 of subsection (3):
 - (c) the GNCB Trust Company Limited, the Companies Act shall, notwithstanding any law, cease to have effect in relation to the said Company, ".

Clause 61 was then passed as amended.

Assembly resumed.

On a motion by the Minister of Finance, the Bill was read the third time and passed as amongod in Committee.
