MOTION

ITEM 1 - MOTION FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE FOR 1995

Assembly resolved itself into Committee of Supply to considet the Estimates of Expenditure for the financial year 1995.

Assembly resumed.

The Senior Minister of Finance reported to the Assembly that the Committee of Supply had completed consideration of the Estimates of Expenditure for the financial year 1995, and had approved of them with an amendment to Head 36. An error of \$12,000,000 in a sub-head was corrected to read \$120,000,000. The total of the Head was therefore amended by the substitution of \$217,195,000 for \$109,195,000.

The Current grand total of \$15,050,333 on the last page of the Schedule to the motion was accordingly amended to read \$15,158,333, and in the resolve clause of the motion, the amount of "thirty billion, six hundred and ninety-three million, two hundred and thirty-two thousand dollars (\$30,693,232,000)" was amended to read "thirty billion, eight hundred and one million, two hundred and thirty-two thousand dollars (\$30,801,232,000)".

The amended motion for the approval of the Estimates of Expenditure for the financial year 1995 was then put and <u>carried</u>.

BILL - First, Second and Third Readings

ITEM 2 APPROPRIATION BILL 1995 - Bill No. 5/1995 published 22.2.95

With the leave of the Speaker, and on a motion by the Senior Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), Standing Orders Nos. 12 and 46 were suspended to enable the Appropriation Bill 1995 to be introduced at this stage and to be further proceeded with at that sitting.

On motions by the Senior Minister of Finance, the following Bill was introduced and was read the first, second and third times and <u>passed</u> as <u>printed:-</u> A BILL intituled AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1995, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

BILL - Second and Third Readings

ITEM 3 - FISCAL ENACTMENTS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1995 - Bill No. 4/1995 published 15.2.95

On a motion by the Senior Minister of Agriculture (Leader of the House), paragraph (3) of Standing Order No. 46 was suspended to enable the Assembly to proceed with the second reading of the Fiscal Enactments (Amendment) Bill 1995.

The Senior Minister of Finance moved the second reading of the following Bill:-

A BILL intituled AN ACT to amend the Tax Act, the Income Tax Act and the Customs Act.

The Bill was read a second time and was thereafter taken through its remaining stages and passed as printed.

That this National Assembly, in accordance with section 5(1) of the Consumption Tax Act, Chapter 80:02, Confirm the Consumption Tax (Amendment) Order 1995 (No. 3 of 1995), which was made on 6th February, 1995, under section 4 of the Consumption Tax Act, Chapter 80:02, and published in the Gazette on 11th February, 1995.
