PRESENTATION OF PETITIONSPrivate Bill

The Clerk read a Petition presented by Miss Ackman, on behalf of Dr. A. Carlyle Miller, of 167 Fifth Street, Campbellville, Georgetown, seeking to have introduced in the Assembly, a Private Bill to incorporate the Guyana Missionary Baptist Church.

The question that the Promoters be allowed to proceed was put and carried.

PUBLIC BUSINESSMOTIONMOTION TO APPROVE THE ESTIMATES OF EXPENDITURE FOR 1973

Assembly resumed the debate on the motion for the approval of the Estimates of Expenditure for the financial year 1973, totalling \$277,712,944. (See Appendix to the Minutes of 7th December, 1972)


(Copies of the Resolution and of the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Committee were circulated to Members on 14th December, 1972.)
