BE IT RESOLVED that his Honourable Council recommend to Government the establishment of a Government controlled insurance for farmers in the Colony against loss of ~~ca~~ **tle** and crops from floods, droughts and other causes and that a Committee be appointed to go into the matter and report thereon.
