Citation and Commencement

The areas hereinafter described 2. In the Schedule below are Hereby reserved for prospecting Operations by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission: but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission.

AREA A

A tract of state Land located in Mazaruni Mining District No. 3 as shown on Topographic Sheets 25SE, 34NE, 26SW and 35NW and described as follows:

From a reference A, located at the Mouth of the Morabisi River on the left bank of the Mazaruni River with geographical co-ordinates, Latitude 5° 49' 16"N, Longitude 59° 27' 25"W, thence at a true bearing of 269° 55' 15" for a distance of 10miles and 101.8 yards to point B with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 5° 58' 10"N, Longitude 59° 45' 01"W, thence at a true bearing of 0° 01' 44" for a distance of 22 miles and 1100.3 yards to point C with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 08' 39"N, Longitude 59° 45' 01"W, thence at a true bearing of 90° 01' 23" for a distance of 12 miles and 122.4 yards to point D with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 6° 08' 38"N, Longitude 59° 23' 01" W, thence at a true bearing of 178° 59' 55" for a distance of 25 miles and 291.9 yards to point E with geographical co-ordinates Latitude 5° 56' 45" N, Longitude 59° 22' 52"W, thence at a true bearing of 211° 05' 35" for a distance of 13 miles and 1157.6 yards to point of commencement A, and enclosing an area of approximately 281,000 acres, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied.
