- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE CT. I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWI G ORDER:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as, the Trade (Regulation of Sale Citation, of Petrol) Order 1986.
 - 2. In thi Order

Interpreta-

- "filling tation" means any petrol pump or filling station in respect of which a licence is required to be taken out under section 61 of the Tax ct;
- "filling station owner" means any person who is required to take out a licence in respect of a filling tation under ection 61 of the Tax et; and Cap. 80:01
- "petrol" means gasolene, diesel fuel or kero ene.
- 3. Except where permission has been granted under clause Restriction 4, any person shall sell or otherwise dispose of or buy or otherwise of acquire any petrol at any filling tation on any weekday (Monday to Friday) only between the hours from 7 a.m. (07.00 hrs) to 4 p.m. (16.00 hrs) and no person hall sell or otherwise dispose of or buy or otherwise acquire any petrol at any filling tation on any Saturday or Sunday.

Permission to seil.

- 4.(1) Where, after taking into account the supplies of petrol available in Guyana, the Minister consider it necessary or convenient for the service of the public to do so, he may give permission to any filling station owner to sell petrol at his filling station on any weekday during the hours prohibited and on any Saturday or Sunday.
 - (2) Any permission granted under thi clause
 - (a)
 - -- (b) may-be-absolute or conditional;
 - (c) may be limited so as to expire on unless renewed;
 - (d) may be revoked by the Minister; and
 - (e) shall be published by the Minister in such a way as in his opinion, to give adequate notice of it to the public, unless in his opinion publication is not necessary.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order seeks to regulate the sale of gasolene, diesel fuel and kerosene by prohibitining filling stations from selling on weekdays except during the hours from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and on weekends, except with the permis ion of the Minister of Trade.
