ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, (Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

- 1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.
- 2. The daily newspapers in which this Order shall be published shall be the "Daily Chronicle" and the "Guiana Graphic".

SCHEDULE

That area lying between Plantation Ithaca and Grant No. 855 on the left bank of the Berbice River, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at the middlewalk of Plantation Zorg-en-Hoop at its junction with the left bank of the Berbice River and proceeding in a westerly direction along the aforesaid middlewalk of Plantation Zorg-en-Hoop to its junction with the western boundary of Plantation Zorg-en-Hoop and continuing in a westerly direction along the southern boundaries of tracts of land held under Leases No. A 4808 and No. A 2708 to the eastern boundary of the tract of land held under Permission No. 19488; thence along the eastern boundaries of the tracts of land held under Permissions No. 19488 and No. 2898 to the north-eastern corner of Grant No. 855; thence along the eastern boundary of Grant No. 855 to its junction with the left bank of the Berbice River; thence in an easterly direction along the left bank of the Berbice River to the point of commencement.
