THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, (Chapter 143).

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Ambramycin and 'Synthomycetine) Order, 1960.
- 2. The following are hereby declared to be antibiotics to which the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance* shall apply —

Ambramycin, all compounds of Ambramycin and all medical preparations containing Ambramycin;

Synthomycetine, all compounds of Synthomycetine and all medical preparations containing Synthomycetine.
