Interpretation.

"cooking gas" means "Liquefied Petroleum Gas";

"retail" and "North West District" have the meanings respectively assigned to them in the Trade (Control of Prices) Order.*

3. The maximum prices at which the goods mentioned in the Maximum retail first column of the Schedule shall be sold by retail in the areas price. mentioned in the second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh columns. respectively, of the said Schedule shall be the price specified in the respective columns.
