WHEREAS by section 2 of the Pounds Ordinance, Chapter 82, it is enacted that the Governor may from time to time by proclamation to be published in the Gazette establish pounds in those parts of the Colony which to him seem fit;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable that pounds shall be established in the Community Areas within the Yakusari and Mibikuri sections of the Black Bush Polder Land Development Scheme in the county of Berbice:

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby, by this proclamation, establish a pound to be kept in the Community Areas within the Yakusari and Mibikuri sections, respectively, of the Black Bush Polder Land Development Scheme in the county of Berbice.
