WHEREAS by section 4(1) of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, it is provided that the President may, from time to time by proclamation published in the Gazette, declare that any road not mentioned in the schedule to the said Ordinance shall be maintained, or constructed and maintained, out of moneys provided by Parliament, and thereupon the provisions of the said Ordinance shall apply to such road in the same manner as if it has been mentioned in the said schedule.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the road specified in the schedule hereto shall be maintained out of moneys provided by Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power in me vested by the said section 4(1) I do hereby declare that the road specified in the schedule hereto shall be maintained out of moneys provided by Parliament.

That part of the branch road known as Sheriff Street, shown on Plan No. RS 305/2 deposited in the Roads Division of the Ministry of Works and Hydraulics, commencing at Station 190+100 situated on Duncan Street, and extending in a southerly direction to Station 179+50 situated on that part of Sheriff Street which crosses the Lamaha Canal thence in a southerly direction across the northern and southern boundaries of the Botanic Gardens, thence in a southerly direction to Station 159+50 situated on Hadfield Street, the total length of Sheriff Street being 0.58 of a mile.
