

PROCLAMATION



D. J. G. ROSE, Governor-General.

By His Exceilency SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS by Proclamation dated 17th May, 1966, issued under section 4(1) of the Guyana Independence Order 1966, and paragraph (1) of article 31 of the Constitution of Guyana, the 26th May, 1966, was appointed the day on which a session of the Parliament of Guyana should commence;

AND WHEREAS a session of Parliament commenced on the said day;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (1) of article 82 of the Constitution of Guyana that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may at any time by proclamation prorogue Parliament:

NOW THEREFORE acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf. I do hereby prorogue Parliament with effect from Tuesday, the thirtieth day of May, 1967.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown, Guyana, this 30th day of May, 1967, and in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
