THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Cap. 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 63(5) OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:—

Citation and commencement. 1. These Regulations, which amend the Wireless Telegraphy Regulations*, may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Amendment) Regulations 1989, and shall come into operation on 1st March, 1989.

Amendment of regulation 20 A of the Principal Regulations

2. Regulation 20A of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "who installs, uses or works" of the words "to whom a licence is granted for installing, using or working".

Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

3. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 20A of the following regulation as regulation 20B-

"Issue of duplicate licence. 20B. Where a licence granted to any person under regulation 20 or 20A is lost, destroyed or mutilated, he may be issued a duplicate licence, which shall be valid for the period of the licence lost, destroyed or mutilated, on payment of —

- (a) in the case of a licence granted under regulation 20, a fee of \$2.00; or
- (b) in the case of a licence granted under regulation 20A, a fee of \$5.00".
