Citation

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Guyana Rice Development Board (Padi and Rice Grading) (Amendment) Regulations 2008.

- Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as tollows.
  - by the substitution in paragraph (2) for the words

    "used in weighing of padi and rice", of the words "and
    the printer attached thereto used in the recording and
    weighing of padi and rice."
  - (b) by the substitution for paragraph 3 of the following paragraph
    - used in the weighing of padi and rice shall be fitted
      with
      - an electronic display which forms an integral part of the scale to show the weight of rice and padi being weighed in kilograms; and
      - (b) a printer attached to the scale to produce documentary information of the weight of the rice and padi recorded by the scale.".

3.

Amendment of regulation 12 of Principal Regulations.

Regulation 12 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by numbering regulation 12 as regulation 12 (1);
- (b) by the insertion immediately after regulation 12
   (1) as renumbered, the following paragraphs as paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) -
- "(2) No person shall tamper or maliciously
  interfere with any scale or printer used in the
  weighing of padi and rice for the purpose of
  showing a greater or lesser weight of the padi or
  rice weighed.
- (3) No person shall operate or be in possession of a scale used in the weighing of padi and rice without there being in force a test certificate required under regulation 3 (2).
- (4) No person shall operate or be in possession of a scale with a capacity in excess of two metric tons used in the weighing of padi and rice that is not fitted with an electronic display which forms an integral part of the scale, or is not fitted with a printer attached to the scale.

- (5) Any person who contravenes paragraphs (2), (3) or (4) shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on summary conviction -
- (a) for a first offence, to a fine of five hundred thousand dollars and in the case of a continuing offence a further fine of one thousand dollars for each day during which the offence continues;
- (b) for a second or subsequent offence, to a fine of five hundred thousand dollars and imprisonment for six months, and in the case of a continuing offence to a further fine of one thousand dollars for every day during which the offence continues."
