REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE (Chapter 309)

UNDER SECTION 273 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE THE FOL-LOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise Department Uniform and Equipment) Regulations, 1972.
- 2. Uniforms and equipment set out in the schedules shall be issued at the time and in the manner prescribed therein to the Officer, Guards and Porters of the Customs and Excise Department referred to in the Schedules.
- 3. Officers, Guards and Porters to whom uniforms and equipment are issued in accordance with these Regulations shall as far as possible during the performance of their duties utilise such uniforms and equipment.
- 4. Officers performing Waterguard duties may wear ornaments applicable to that section of the Department.
- 5. All uniforms and equipment issued shall remain the property of the Government and shall be returned to the stores on the Officer, Guard, or Porter leaving the service of the Department or on the request of the Comptroller.

- 6. All uniforms and equipment issued shall be recorded by the store-keeper who shall take receipts for all issues and upon their return to him the store-keeper shall record the particulars thereof in the presence of the Officer, Guard, or Porter returning the articles.
- 7. All Officers, Guards, and Porters when proceeding on vacation leave, or when absent from duty for any period in excess of one calendar month, shall return to the store-keeper all uniforms and equipment for safe keeping.
- 8. Where the certificate of the store-keeper discloses a deficiency in the articles returned the equivalent value of any such deficiency may be deducted from any moneys accruing to that Officer, or Guard or Porter.
- 9. The Customs and Excise Department (Uniform and Equipment) Regulations, 1952* are hereby revoked.
