### REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE MINING ACT

(No. 20 of 1989)

**IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTIONS 67 AND 135 OF THE MINING ACT 1989 AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATION:-**

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Special) Regulations No. 13 of 2021 and shall come into effect on the 17<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and shall cease to have effect upon the expiration or termination of the permit granted under these Regulations.

Application

2. These Regulations shall apply only for the purposes of and in relation to the application and grant of a non-renewable and non-transferrable Special Mining Permit to the Rupununi Miners Association Co-Operative Society Limited only in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in Schedule 2 and over the areas as described in Schedule 1 hereunder.

Application for  
Special Mining Permits

3. Application for the non-renewable and non-transferrable Special Mining Permit for areas and in accordance with the terms and description stated in Schedule 1, shall be made by the Rupununi Miners Association Co-Operative Society Limited immediately upon gazetting of this regulation in accordance with Section 43(3) of the Mining Act and all other applicable sections thereof.

Grant of Special Mining  
Permit

4. Subject to the satisfaction of the terms and conditions contained in Schedule 2, the non-transferrable Special Mining Permit shall be granted for a maximum non-renewable period of 5 years from the date of Grant, strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in Schedule 2 and over the area stated in Schedule 1.

Savings Clause

5. The Mining Regulations in all other respects shall apply.

Schedule 1

Tract of state land located in the Rupununi Mining District. No.6 as shown on Terra Surveys Topographic Map 77SE, at scale 1:50,000 with reference point 'X' located at Bat Mountain with geographical coordinates of Longitude **59°10'36"W** and Latitude **2°10'38"N**

Thence at a true bearing of **48°**, for a distance of **1 mile 1347 yards**, to the point of commencement:

**Point A**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°9'28.001"W** and latitude **2°11'39.998"**, thence at true bearing of **360°**, for a distance of approximately **1 mile 435.678 yards**, to **Point B**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°9'28.001"W** and latitude **2°12'45.0"**, thence at true bearing of **270.0°**, for a distance of approximately **742.569 yards**, to **Point C**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°9'50.0"W** and latitude **2°12'45.0"**, thence at true bearing of **360°**, for a distance of approximately **709.317 yards**, to **Point D**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°9'50.0"W** and latitude **2°13'5.999"**, thence at true bearing of **270.0°**, for a distance of approximately **371.222 yards**, to **Point E**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°10'.998"W** and latitude **2°13'5.999"**, thence at true bearing of **315.02°**, for a distance of approximately **477.565 yards**, to **Point F**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°10'10.999"W** and latitude **2°13'16.0"**, thence at true bearing of **44.96°**, for a distance of approximately **334.278 yards**, to **Point G**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°10'4.001"W** and latitude **2°13'23.002"**, thence at true bearing of **127.9°**, for a distance of approximately **1154.93 yards**, to **Point H**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°9'37.001"W** and latitude **2°13'1.999"**, thence at true bearing of **90.0°**, for a distance of approximately **1 mile 501.474 yards**, to **Point I**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°8'30.001"W** and latitude **2°13'1.999"**, thence at true bearing of **180.0°**, for a distance of approximately **506.603 yards**, to **Point J**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°8'30.001"W** and latitude **2°12'47.002"**, thence at true bearing of **231.68°**, for a distance of approximately **817.278 yards**, to **Point K**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°8'48.998"W** and latitude **2°12'32.0"**, thence at true bearing of **179°**, for a distance of approximately **1756.90 yards**, to **Point L**, located at geographical coordinates of longitude **59°8'48.001"W** and latitude **2°11'39.998"**, thence at true bearing of **270.0°**, for a distance of approximately **1350.14 yards**, to the point of commencement at **Point A**

With maximum depth of 48 meters or 160 feet measured vertically from a point at or near the collar of Diamond Drill MR 94099 and which has a deemed elevation of 424 meters; thus, the floor or base level boundary of the MP is 48 meters vertically below this point at a deemed elevation 376 meters.


Thus enclosing an area of approximately **1012 acres**, save and except all lands lawfully held or occupied. All lands, surficially constrained by the description above, but lying below a horizontal

base/floor level projected using the 376-meter contour elevation, is hereby excluded from the Mining Permit
