IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 26 OF THE FACTORIES ACT. I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING **REGULATIONS:-**

- These Regulations, which amend the Factories (Health and Citation. Welfare) Regulations*, may be cited as the Factories (Health and Welfare) (Amendment) Regulations 1983.
- 2. Regulation 2 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amend- Amendment of Regulated by the deletion of the word "male" from the definition of the 2 of the "young person".
- 3. Regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations is hereby Amendment of regulation amended by the deletion of the words "and no female".

 4. Regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations is hereby Amendment of regulation 10 of the Principal Regulations.
- Regulation 17 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects
 - in paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or any Principal Regulations. female;
 - in paragraph (b) of the proviso to paragraph (1) by the deletion of the words "or female"; and
- in paragraph (2) by the deletion of the words "and female".
- 5. Regulation 18 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amendment of regulation by the deletion of the words "and females".

 6. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows
- amended as follows-
 - (a) by the deletion of the words "women and";
 - (b) by the deletion of column 2;
 - by renumbering columns (3) to (8) (inclusive) as (2) to (7) respectively; and
 - by the substitution in column (6) as renumbered for the words "Columns (5) and (6)" of the words "Columns (4) and (5)".
