AN ACT to amend the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, 1956.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) Act, 1970, and amends the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, 1956, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of the Principal Ordinance.

- 2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects
  - (a) by the insertion of the words "or drugs" immediately after the word "poisons" where it first appears in section 43(1) (b);
  - (b) by the substitution of the following subparagraph for subparagraph (i) of section 43(1)(b)—
    - "(i) regulating or restricting the sale or supply of poisons or drugs by licensed sellers of poisons or by any class of such persons and prohibiting the sale of any specified poisons or drugs or class of poisons or drugs by such persons, and ";
  - (c) by the insertion of the words "or drugs" after the word "poisons" in section 43(1)(g); and
  - (d) by the substitution of the word "Minister" for the words "Governor in Council" and "Governor" wherever they respectively appear in the Principal Ordinance.
