Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Constitution) Act, 1970.

Amendment of section 36 of the Federal Supreme Court (Appeals) Ordinance, 1958. No. 19 of 1958. No. 37 of 2. The Federal Supreme Court (Appeals) Ordinance, 1958, as adapted and modified by the Guyana Independence (Adaptation and Modification of Laws) (Judicature) Order, 1966, in relation to the Court of Appeal shall have effect as if the word "five" were substituted for the word "three" in section 36(1).
