An Ordinance to amend the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Ordinance, 1946, with respect to the power of entry and examination of bakeries.

[7th May, 1949].

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title. No. 4 of

1946.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Bakeries (Hours of Work) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Ordinance, 1946, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of subsection

(1) of section 7 of the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 8 of the Principal Ordin-

- 2. Subsection (1) of section seven of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "any Inspector of Labour or any Assistant Inspector of Labour" of the following—
 - "any Inspector of Labour, any Assistant Inspector of Labour or any officer or sub-officer of police".
- Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
 - (a) by the substitution of the words "Examining Officer" for the words "Commissioner of Labour" wherever the latter words appear in subsection (3) thereof; and
 - (b) by the substitution for subsection (5) of the following subsection—
 - "(5) In subsection (3) of this section the expression "Examining Officer" means the Commissioner of Labour or other officer specified in subsection (1) of section seven of this Ordinance."
