ORDINANCE No. 15 OF 1949

An Ordinance further to amend the Civil List Ordinance by A.D. 1949. increasing the amount which shall be payable to His Majesty for defraying the expenses of certain services.

[1st October, 1949.]

Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows: -

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Civil List (Amend-Short ment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be construed with the Civil List title. Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Cap. 52.
