Be it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Co-operative Societies Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Co-operative Societies Ordinance, 1948, hereinafter No. 12 of referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section twenty-one of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendamended by the substitution of a colon for the full-stop at the ment of end of the section and by the addition of the following proviso — Section 21 of the "Provided that a pupil attending any school, may, not-Principal withstanding the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of Ordinance. this section, with the consent in writing of the Director of Education, be registered as a member of a society."
